- 1000 to 1999 points - add 10 ribbons to certificate & seal

- 900 to 999 points - add 9 ribbons to certificate & seal
- 800 to 899 points - add 8 ribbons to certificate & seal
- 700 to 799 points - add 7 ribbons to certificate & seal
- 600 to 699 points - add 6 ribbons to certificate & seal
- 500 to 599 points - add 5 ribbons to certificate & seal
- 50 to 499 points - certificate & seal
