<sup>\*\*</sup> Adult students may register to play on any Solo Festival date, but Concerto and Duet Festivals participants will play on February 17 at the Samford Academy of the Arts.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> The Solo Festival on February 24 is currently TBA, and if we have a festival on that date, it will be limited to two rooms. Please try to have your students come on either February 10 or February 17. If you have students who are unable to perform in the first two festivals, please contact us as soon as possible, **no later than November 1.** 

All teachers who enter students in Piano Festivals are also required to judge or work at festivals, based upon the above number of students they register to enter. A teacher's judging assignment is based on the number of students that they **register** to enter, and will remain the same regardless of how many students that teacher actually enters in festivals; however, a teacher may also be fined if the number of students they enter is **significantly less** than the number of students they registered to enter. **If a teacher enters 12-19 students** fewer than they registered to enter, they must pay a fine of \$75. If a teacher enters 20 or more students fewer than they registered to enter, they must pay a fine of \$150.
